For this **session**, we will be applying the same hygiene concept as the University.

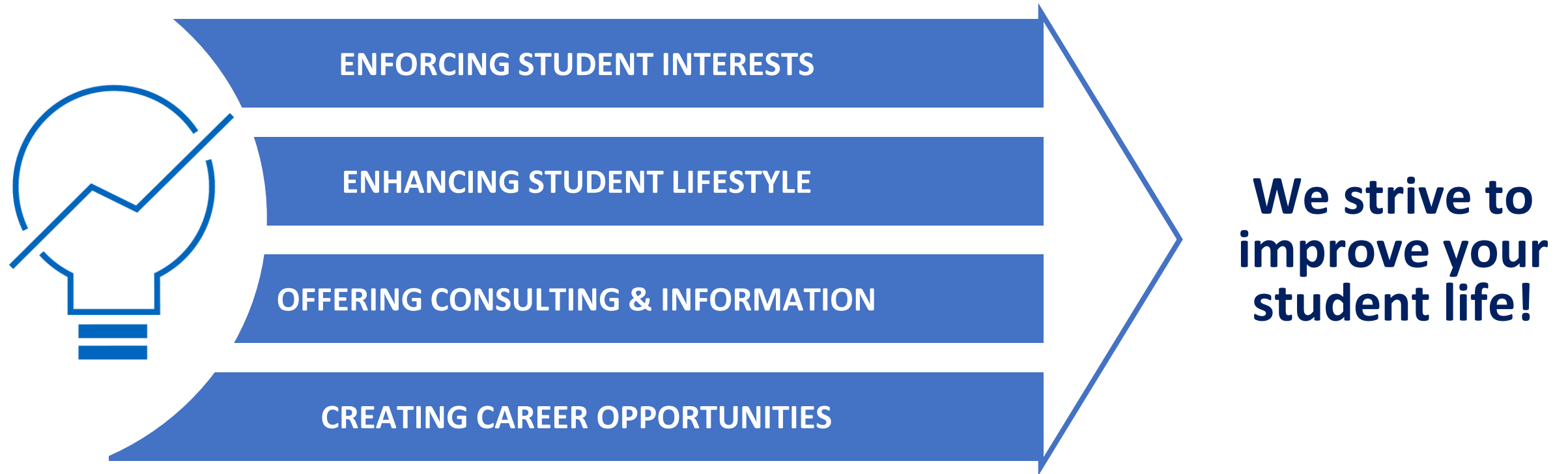
- **3G Certificate:** you must show proof of a negative test, vaccination certificate, or being recovered in the last six months.

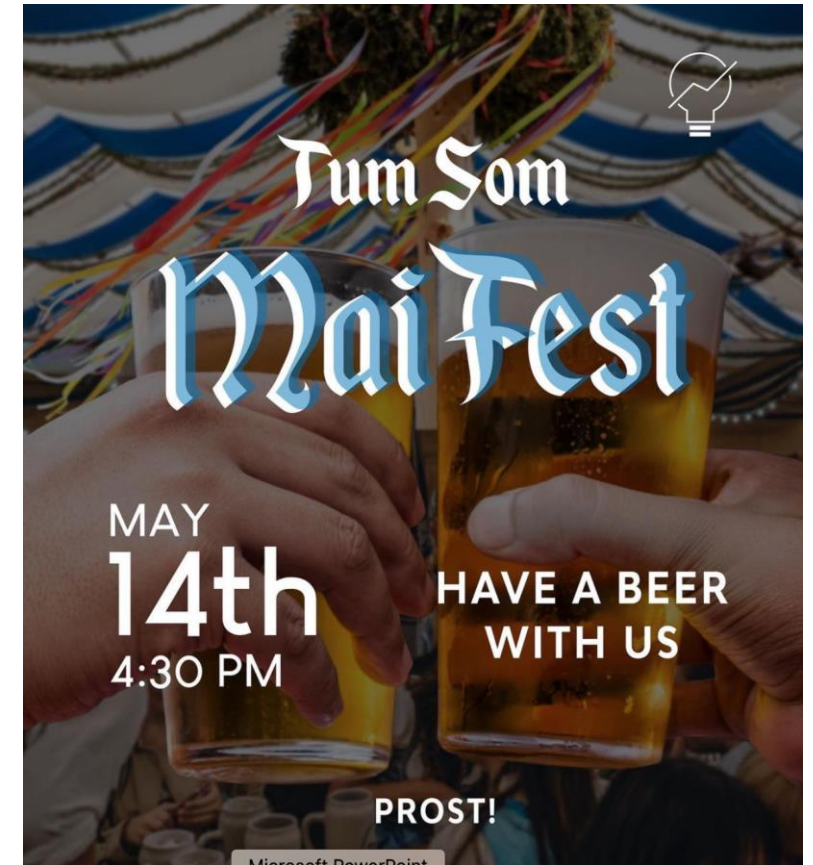
Running Dinners

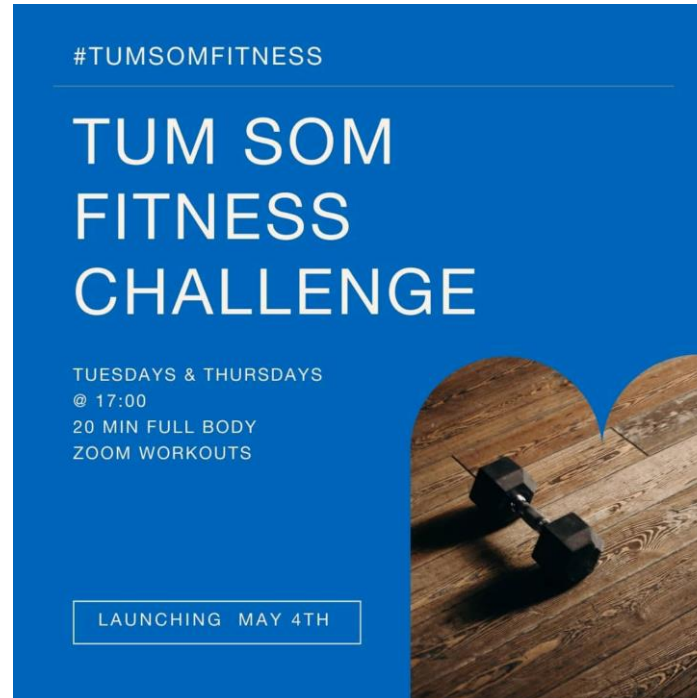


Cultural Nights

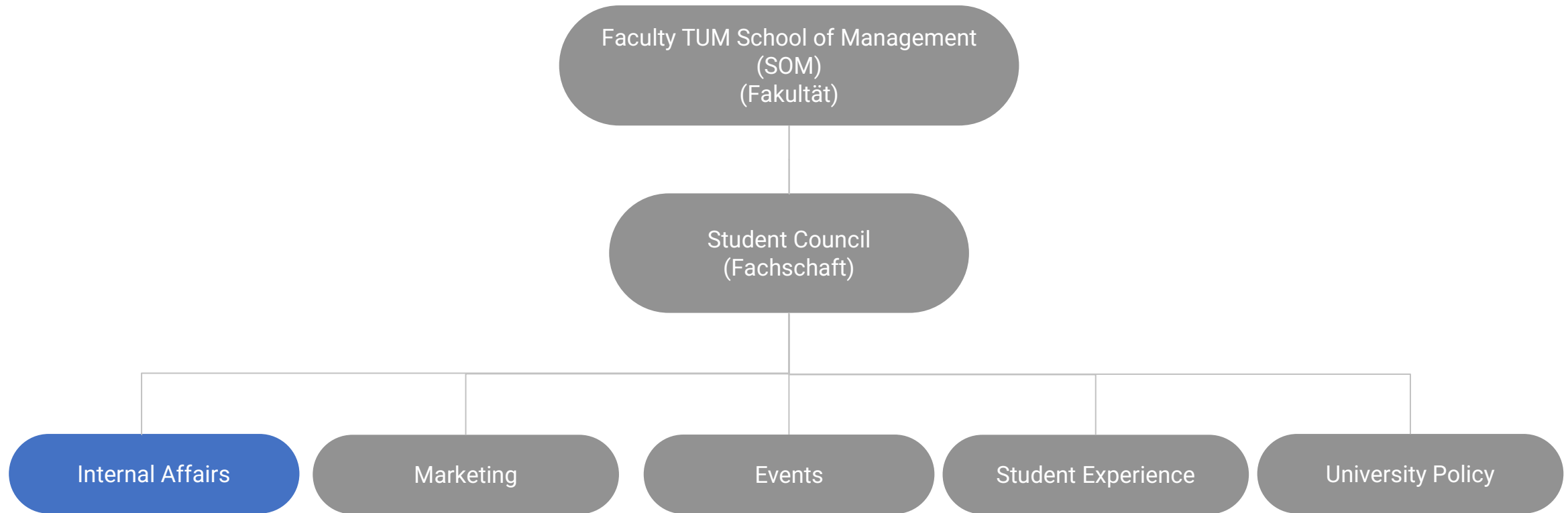


We also organize a handful of other miscellaneous events. For example during the Pandemic we did online sports classes, a running challenge, etc.
